

Rescue Line Entry Rules 2019 (Final)

January 20th, 2019

Basic Rules

The rules for the Rescue Line Entry League 2019 are based on the international rules of RoboCupJunior Rescue Line (as of **January 20th, 2019**).

The following changes apply for the Rescue Line Entry League:

Age Limitation

The Rescue Line Entry League is open to students in the age from 10 to 14 years (age as of 1st of July).

Bumper, Debris and Obstacles

There will be no bumpers, debris or obstacles in the evacuation zone.

There will be no bumpers on tiles with elements you can score points with (e.g. gaps, intersections, ramps).

There will be free space in a radius of 25 cm around each obstacle, to allow the robot to pass on both sides of the obstacle.

Intersections and Dead Ends

There will be no intersection markers. Instead the organization committee will announce the direction of the path before a round is going to start (At least 30 minutes before the first scoring run). The direction of the path (**left or right**) may differ from round to round.

There will be no dead ends.

There will be no gaps or bumpers on the tile ahead of an intersection.

Evacuation Point Tiles and Victims

There will be only evacuation point tiles of level one.

There will be only living victims.

40 points are awarded per successful rescue of a live victim.

No deduction of points is given for rescued victims after a Lack of Progress behind the last Checkpoint.

No points will be awarded for leaving the evacuation zone.
